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21 The District Attorney of San Luis Obispo County, California, hereby accuses the  
22 above named defendant of the following criminal offenses:

23 Count 1

24 On or about November 21, 2022, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the  
25 crime of Vehicular Manslaughter in violation of Penal Code section 192(c)(1), a Felony,  
26 was committed in that DANIEL ANGEL SALIGANPATRICIO did unlawfully, and without  
27 malice, kill J. Besser, a human being, while driving a vehicle in the commission of an  
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1 unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and while driving a  
2 vehicle in the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful  
3 manner, and with gross negligence.

4  
5 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections  
6 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

8 Count 2

9 On or about November 21, 2022, in the County of San Luis Obispo, State of California, the  
10 crime of Vehicular Manslaughter in violation of Penal Code section 192(c)(1), a Felony,  
11 was committed in that DANIEL ANGEL SALIGANPATRICIO did unlawfully, and without  
12 malice, kill M. Chachere, a human being, while driving a vehicle in the commission of an  
13 unlawful act, not amounting to a felony, and with gross negligence; and while driving a  
14 vehicle in the commission of a lawful act which might have produced death, in an unlawful  
15 manner, and with gross negligence.

16  
17 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code sections  
18 1192.7(c) and 1192.8(a).

19  
20 It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code Section 1170(b)(2) that one or more of the  
21 following factors in aggravation listed in California Rule of Court 4.421 may apply to the  
22 defendant(s) or to conduct of the defendant(s):

23 4.421(a)(1) The crime involved great violence, great bodily harm, threat of great bodily  
24 harm, and other acts disclosing a high degree of cruelty, viciousness and callousness.

25 4.421(a)(2) The defendant was armed with or used a weapon at the time of the  
26 commission of the crime.

27 4.421(a)(3) The victim was particularly vulnerable.  
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- 1 4.421(a)(4) The defendant induced others to participate in the commission of the crime  
2 and occupied a position of leadership and dominance of other participants in its  
3 commission.
- 4 4.421(a)(5) The defendant induced a minor to commit and assist in the commission of the  
5 crime.
- 6 4.421(a)(6) The defendant threatened witnesses, unlawfully prevented and dissuaded  
7 witnesses from testifying, suborned perjury, and in any other way illegally interfered with  
8 the judicial process.
- 9 4.421(a)(7) The defendant is charged with other crimes for which consecutive sentences  
10 can be imposed but for which concurrent sentences shall be imposed.
- 11 4.421(a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning,  
12 sophistication, and professionalism.
- 13 4.421(a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary  
14 value.
- 15 4.421(a)(10) The crime involved a large quantity of contraband.
- 16 4.421(a)(11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust and confidence to commit  
17 the offense.
- 18 4.421(a)(12) The crime constitutes a hate crime under section 422.55 of the Penal Code  
19 and no hate crime enhancements under section 422.75 of the Penal Code shall be  
20 imposed and the crime is not subject to sentencing under section 1170.8 of the Penal  
21 Code.
- 22 4.421(b)(1) The defendant has engaged in violent conduct that indicates a serious danger  
23 to society.
- 24 4.421(b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult and sustained petitions in  
25 juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous and of increasing seriousness.
- 26 4.421(b)(3) The defendant has served a prior term in prison and county jail under section  
27 1170(h).

1 4.421(b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post release  
2 community supervision, and parole when the crime was committed.

3 4.421(b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post  
4 release community supervision, and parole was unsatisfactory.

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1 Contrary to the form, force and effect of that statute in such cases made and  
2 provided and against the peace and dignity of the people of the State of California.
