SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY, BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, DISTRICT 4 ELECTION RECOUNT

SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA-July 17, 2022- Pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 15625 and 15628, under the supervision of the election's official, there will be a recount of the ballots cast in the June 7, 2022, Statewide Direct Primary Election for the office of Board of Supervisors, District 4 at the request of Darcia Stebbens on behalf of candidate Lynn Compton.

The recount process will begin at 9:00 am in the San Luis Obispo County Government Center, 1055 Monterey Street, Room D120, San Luis Obispo on Tuesday, July 19, 2022, and thereafter every day until completed or terminated.

The recount process will begin at 9:00 A.M. and end at 4:00 P.M. on a daily basis, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays excepted until completed or terminated. The process of manually recounting a contest has many required steps. Beginning with the separation of ballots for the precincts that do and do not contain the contest. Once the ballots are separated, the special recount board(s) will begin with manually re-tabulating the votes in the precinct order specified by the requester.

This Board of Supervisors, District 4 election recount is being conducted pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 15629 and 15630, which requires that the recount process be conducted publicly.

Pursuant to the request for recount and ballot inspection, this recount will be conducted manually as detailed in California Election Code 15627.
